

The Younger Chemists Committee of the St. Louis Section American Chemical Society invites undergraduates to apply for the YCC Young Researcher Award!



This award is open to undergraduate students who have performed research over the summer or past academic year. Two award winners will receive \$250 towards expenses to attend the annual Midwest Regional Meeting of the American Chemical Society – held in Springfield, MO on October 16-19.

Application Details: The application should include (a) a copy of the abstract to be submitted; (b) 2 letters of recommendation for the student (including one from the mentor of the student, which may be at another institution/company if the research was performed during an REU/internship); (c) copy of Transcript with coursework/grades (does not need to be official); (d) letter from the student describing their career goals, reasons for wanting to attend an ACS meeting, and which session of the meeting they intend to present at (no more than 2 pages in length); (e) description from the Department of the financial support that they have committed to the student for travel (if any).

Deadline: Applications are due August 1, 2013. Award winners will be contacted by August 15 and are expected to submit their abstracts online by the abstract submission deadline.

Note: This award will aid in covering costs associated with registration, travel, and accommodations. Additionally, the award may be used for poster printing if the student's institution does not have printing facilities. The student or Department will be responsible for upfront payment, and expenses up to \$250 will be reimbursed following submission of receipts to the YCC Chair.
