Karl Markl started work at Anheuser-Busch Inc. as a lab tech in the Brewery Research Lab, where he later became manager of the Pilot Brewery for seven years. After leaving ABI, he studied tasting methods for analyzing foods and beverages at Arthur D. Little in Cambridge, MA, and was the Research Manager in the Flavor Chemistry Lab at the Technical Center. Karl then started his own lab tracking the development and disposition of flavor constituents, analyzing raw materials, in-process, finished product, oxidation and packaging materials when off-flavors develop to determine the source of contamination and how to remove the off-flavor. He was also involved in litigation against ABI by analyzing samples suspected of containing contaminates. Karl became Chair of the St. Louis Section of the American Chemical Society in 1999. He retired early to pursue the study of lutherie, and now custom builds classical guitars and ukuleles. Karl also writes music books, composes musical arrangements, and teaches music at St. Louis Community College– Meramec. He is a founding member of the St. Louis Ukulele Group and a member of St. Louis Banjo Club.
